We all remember being young and not being able to drive. Lack of access to a car can negatively impact a young person's independence, social participation and employment opportunities. At Craig Davis College, we are starting a program to teach our students to drive – but we need you.

Our iDrive program assists young people to obtain their driver's licence by connecting them with volunteers who teach them how to drive a motor vehicle. While we do not require you to volunteer for all 120 hours, we would appreciate any available time that you have. The young people will have completed at least five professional driving lessons before undertaking this program with you. You need to have a full driver's licence, along with patience and understanding.
